iTEP Global Placement Structure

In each section, examinees will encounter content and questions targeted to varying levels of proficiency.

A Grammar — 4 minutes/ one part

Ten fill-in-the-blank, multiple-choice questions testing the examinee’s familiarity with a key feature of English structure; questions range from beginner to advanced.

B Listening — 2 minutes/ two parts

Part 1 Six high-beginning to low-intermediate level short conversations of two to three sentences, each followed by one multiple-choice question.

Part 2 One two- to three minute intermediate level conversation, followed by four multiple-choice questions.

C Vocabulary — 4 minutes/ two parts

Part 1 Five fill-in-the-blank, multiple-choice questions.

Part 2 Four multiple-choice questions testing the examinee’s familiarity with synonyms.

D Reading — 17 minutes/ two parts

Part 1 One low-intermediate level passage (160 words) followed by four multiple-choice questions.

Part 2 One upper-level passage (450 words) followed by six multiple choice questions.
